

WELCOME TO COOKTOWN

SIGHTS AND ATTRACTIONS

- 1 **Cooktown Wharf** – popular meeting place and fishing spot for visitors and locals
- 2 **The Queen's Steps** – made for HM Queen Elizabeth II for her visit in 1970
- 3 **Mick the Miner** – in memory of the Palmer River Gold Rush
- 4 **Chinese Monument** – celebrates the contribution that the Chinese migrants made to Cooktown
- 5 **Milbi Wall** – created by local Aboriginal artists
- 6 **James Cook Statue** – erected to celebrate the bicentenary
- 7 **Musical Ship** – ship-shaped musical playground
- 8 **James Cook Monument** – commemorates Cook's landing on 17 June 1770
- 9 **Cannon** – dating from 1881
- 10 **Stone Cairn** – where James Cook beached HM Bark Endeavour
- 11 **Jackey-Jackey Store** – built in 1886
- 12 **Cooktown History Centre** – family research facility
- 13 **The Boathouse** – home of the Re-enactment Association
- 14 **Mrs Watson's Monument** – erected in 1886
- 15 **The Old Bank** – built in 1891 for the Queensland National Bank
- 16 **Cooktown Creative Arts Centre** – originally the Cooktown Railway Station
- 17 **Leopard Tank at Anzac Park** – donated to the Cooktown RSL Sub Branch by the Commonwealth of Australia
- 18 **National Trust James Cook Museum** – home to 'Endeavour Anchor and Cannon'. Originally a convent school, built in 1889.
- 19 **The Cemetery and Chinese Shrine** – oldest grave dates back to 1874.
- 20 **Gunpowder Magazine** – built in 1874
- 21 **Grassy Hill and Lighthouse** – superb 360 degree views of Cooktown and the Coral Sea. Caravans and trailers not recommended.
- 22 **Botanic Gardens** – amongst the oldest in Australia
- 23 **The Old Hospital** – now the Kingdom Hall
- 24 **PCYC Cooktown Events Centre and Gym**
- 25 **Nature's Powerhouse** – Visitor Information Centre, Café, Gift Shop, Gallery, Exhibition Space
- 26 **RV Rest Area** – Fully self-contained vehicles only
- 27 **Reconciliation Rocks Precinct** – believed to be the site of the first recorded act of reconciliation between Indigenous Australians and Europeans
